Reformation and Revival in the Church Today *Studies in Haggai*

Prof. Robert McCollum is Professor of Pastoral Theology and Homiletics at the Reformed Theological College, Belfast, and Minister of Lisburn Reformed Presbyterian Church.

Robert grew up on the family farm on the outskirts of Coleraine as a member of the Ballyclabber RPC. After hearing God's Call into the Christian ministry, he received his theological training at the Reformed Presbyterian Theological Hall, Belfast, followed by a Masters Degree in Theology from Queen's University.

Robert was ordained to the pastoral ministry in Ballylaggan RPC, serving six years before he was called to a church planting ministry in Lisburn.

Twenty-eight years on, he continues to serve Christ in Lisburn. Pastoral exchanges with Quinter Kansas RPC, and San Francisco OPC, proved to be interesting and profitable experiences for him in cross-cultural ministry.
