The local Session of each congregation is encouraged to mark the exams done by the pupils from the congregation and award prizes accordingly. The Committee will, however, continue to mark any completed papers returned to it before Friday 11th January 2013.

Scripture: Portions selected from the Programme for the Examination will be published in the Committee's report to Synod. Lessons for the Primary, Junior, Intermediate and Senior examinations are published by the Committee. The examination will be based on the Scripture passage and the pupils' worksheet on these lessons.

Psalms: Sabbath Schools may choose to memorise the version of the Psalms which they prefer. The portions defined in this programme are from the *21st Century Edition*.
