Reformed Presbyterian Summer Camps aim to provide enjoyable and worthwhile holidays for children and young people within and outside the Reformed Presbyterian Church family. The camps are planned and led by committed Christians who are keen to share their faith. These camps are therefore organised with a view to helping those who attend to grow in their understanding of Christian belief and practice.

What is included in the cost?

The cost of the camp includes accommodation, food, activities, craft materials and public liability insurance. All cheques should be made payable to the camp that you wish to attend - eg 'Reformed Presbyterian Boys' Discovery Camp'. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Book early to avoid disappointment.

What are the camp rules?

As in all situations where people live together there have to be some rules, although we try to keep these to a minimum. Campers are expected to help with routine chores. Campers are not allowed to leave the camp area without permission. Smoking and the possession or use of alcohol and illegal substances is prohibited at all of our camps. In the event of a serious or continual breach of camp rules we reserve the right to arrange for a camper to be taken home.

How do I apply?

Having identified the camp which you plan to attend, complete the booking form, filling in the necessary details. This form together with a £30 deposit and two stamped self-addressed envelopes should be sent to the appropriate camp leader. The envelopes are needed because the camp leader will be communicating with you before camp.
